


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An tSraith Pictiúr


Lá spraoi san Ardchathair

Pictiúr 1




- I bpictiúr a haon, feicimind Ciara agus a máthair ag aerfort Baile Átha Cliath.

- Sofia really enjoys the tour, she hasn't seen anything like it before!


Pictiúr 3

Pictiúr 1



- Sa chéad phictiúr, feictear Seán ina chodladh go sámh.
In the first picture, Seán is seen peacefully asleep.
- Tá sé beag beann ar an drochaimsir lasmuigh, atá le feiceáil tríd an bhfuinneog.
He is oblivious to the rain shower outside, which can be seen through the window.
- Lá na lacha atá ann gan aon agó, agus tá an tsráid tréigthe.
It is a day for the ducks, without a doubt, and the street was deserted.

Pictiúr 2



- Is léir go ndeachaigh cursaí aimsire in olcas i rith na hoíche - nuair a dhúisíonn Seán bocht, tá ciseal uisce ag clúdach an úrláir!
It is clear that the weather worsened during the night – when poor Seán wakes up, there is a layer of water covering the floor!
- Tá leibhéal an uisce ag ardú, agus baintear stangadh as Seán. Níl a fhios aige cad ba chóir dó a dhéanamh.
The water level is rising, and Sean gets a shock. He doesn't know what to do.
- Tá cosa Sheáin agus cosa na cathaoireach faoi cheilt ag an uisce. Tá éadaí chodladh Sheáin fluich báite.
You can see that Seán's feet and the chair's legs are hidden by the water. Seán's pyjamas are drenched.

Pictiúr 3



- Déanann Seán tréan-iarracht éalú ón teach, ach tá an doras tosaigh greamaithe de dheasca an uisce.
Seán makes a big effort to escape the house, but the front door is stuck due to the water.
- Claonann Seán amach leac na fuinneoige agus tosaíonn sé ag béicíl in árd a chinn 's a ghutha. Tá sé ag iarraidh airde a tharraingt ar fhéin.
Seán leans out of the windowsill and starts to shout at the top of his voice. He is trying to bring attention to himself.
- Tá an t-ádh leis – cloiseann beirt dhéagóir é ag screadaíl. Tá said suite ar bhalla os comhair teach Sheáin
He is lucky – two teenagers hear him shouting. They are sitting on a wall in front of Seán's house.

Pictiúr 4



- Cruinníonn an bheirt a misneach, agus coileann siad tríd an uisce i dtreo Sheáin.

The pair gather their courage, and they tread through the water towards Seán.

- Chomh luath is a shroicheann siad Seán, cuireann an cailín, Caitríona, fios ar na seirbhísí éigeandála. Tá sí ullmhaithe leis an seoladh baile.

As soon as they reach Seán, the girl, Caitríona, calls the emergency services. She is ready with the address.

- Déanann an buachaill, Daire, Seán a choimead ar a shuaimhneas. 'Fanfaimid leat' deir sé, 'ná bí buartha'. Tá Seán an-bhuíoch as an gcomhluadar agus as an gcabhair.

The boy, Daire, keeps Seán calm. 'We'll stay with you' he says, 'don't worry'. Seán is very thankful for the company and for the help.

- Gan mhoill, tagann lucht an dóiteáin chun cabhair a thabhairt.

Déanann siad tarrtháil tapa ar Sheán, agus éalaíonn sé tríd an bhfuinneog le beagáinín cúnaimh. Ar scáth a chéile a mhaireann na daoine, mar a deir an seanfhocal!

Before long, the firemen arrive to help. They save Seán quickly, and he escapes through the window with a bit of assistance. No man is an island, as they say!

- Tá feistisiú uisce-dhíonach ar an lucht éigeandála, ach tá Seán, Daire agus Caitríona fluich go craiceann, agus préachta leis an bhfuacht.

The emergency unit are wearing water-proof clothing, but Seán, Daire and Caitríona are soaked, and frozen by the cold.

- Tá leibhéal an uisce fós ag dul in airde. Is í an tuile is measa a tharla imbaile Sheáin le blianta beaga anuas.

The water level is still rising. It is the worst flood to happen in Seán's town in recent years

- I bhfaiteadh na súl, tá Seán slán sábhálte agus ar ais sa leaba.

Faraor, ní mór dó oíche a chaitheamh san ospidéal, ach tá súil aige go dtiocfadh biseach air go luath.

In the blink of an eye, Seán is safe and sound and back in bed. Unfortunately, he has to spend a night in hospital, but he is hoping to recover soon.

- Fanann Caitríona agus Daire i dteannta Sheán an t-am ar fad. Tá faoiseamh orthu go bhfuil sé go breá. Tá meangadh gáire orthu uilig.

Caitríona and Daire stay with Seán the whole time. They are relieved that he is okay. They are all smiling.

- Gabhann Seán míle buíochas leo, agus measann sé gur déagóirí rí-chróga iad. Tá náire orthu agus geallann siad nách raibh fadhb ar bith ag baint leis.

Seán thanks them, and thinks that they are very brave teenagers. They are embarrassed, and promise him that it was not a problem.

Rialacha na Scoile

Pictiúr 1



- Sa chéad phictiúr feicimid príomhoide Ardscoil an Chnoic agus í ar a slí go dtí an tionól seachtainiúil.

In the first picture, we see the principle of Ardscoil an Chnoic on her way to the weekly assembly.

- Ag an tionól seo, labhróidh sí le daltaí na scoile faoi imeachtaí na seachtaíne agus mar is gnáth, rachaidh sí trí rialacha na scoile. At this assembly, she'll talk to the students about the events of the week, and as per usual, she'll go through the school rules.
- Is iad na rialacha atá acu ná; meas a bheith ar chách, éide scoile a chaitheamh, an scoil a choimeád mar shuíomh sona, obair go dícheallach, gan bhulaíocht a dhéanamh, gan ghuma a chogaint nó tobac a chaitheamh agus faoi dheireadh, gan alcól a ól nó drúgaí a thógáil.

The rules they have are; respect everyone, wear uniforms, keep the school as a happy place, word diligently, don't bully, don't chew gum or smoke and finally, don't drink alcohol or take drugs.

Pictiúr 2



- I pictiúr a dó is fóllas nár éist roinnt de na daltaí leis an bpriomhoide agus feicimid iad ag briseadh na rialacha.

In Picture 2 it's clear that some of the students didn't listen to the principle and we see them breaking the rules.

- Tá buachaillí ann ag imirt peile ach go tobann tosnaíonn siad ag troid, ní suíomh sona é ar aon nós!
- There are boys playing football but suddenly they start to fight, it's nos a happy place anyway!
- Ansín feicimid cailíní ag briseadh na rialacha freisin taobh thiar den bhothán rothar agus iad ag caitheamh tobaic.
- Then we see girls breaking the rules as well behind the bike shed smoking.

Pictiúr 3



- I bpictiúr a trí, beireann beirt mhúinteoir, an tUasal Ó Briain agus Bean Uí Thuama ar na daltaí a bhris rialacha na scoile.

In picture 3, two teachers, Mr. O'Brien and Mrs. Twomey catch the students who broke the school rules.

- Tá siad an-chrosta leo. Cuireann an tUasal Ó Briain i gcuimhne do na buachaillí a bhí ag troid gurb iad rialacha na scoile meas a bheith ar a chéile agus suíomh sona a chruthú. Fiafraíonn sé díobh an bhfuil aon rud le rá acu.

They are very cross with them. Mr. O'Brien reminds the boys who were fighting that the school rules are to show respect for each other and to create a happy place. He asks them have they anything to say.

- I gcás na gcailíní, tá Bean Uí Thuama ag tabhairt amach chomh maith. Deir sí go ndéanann tobac dochar dá sláinte agus gur cur amú airgid é.

In the girls' case, Mrs. Twomey is giving out as well. She says that smoking does damage to your health and it's a waste of money.


- Nuair a théann na daltaí abhaile, ceistíonn a dtuismitheoirí iad.
When the students go home, their parents interrogate them.
- Deir siad go bhfuair siad glaoch ón scoil sa tráthnóna ag rá go raibh a bpáiste i trioblóid; fiafraíonn siad díobh cad a rinne siad.
They say they received a call from the school in the afternoon saying that their child was in trouble; they ask them what they did.
- Dar leo, beidh cruinní acu leis an bPríomhoide ar maidin faoi.
According to them, there will be a meeting with the principal in the morning about this.
- Tá ionadh agus scanradh ar na daltaí, tá a fhios acu go bhfuil siad i bpconc ceartanois.
The students are shocked and scared. They know now that they're in a proper fix.

- I pictiúr a cúig, feicimid Seán, duine de na buachaillí troiblóideach lena thuismitheoirí os comhair an Phríomhoide.
In picture 5, we see Seán, one of the troublesome boys, with his parents in front of the principal.
- Insíonn an Príomhoide leo cad a tharla. Níl tuismitheoirí Sheáin sásta agus tá náire ar Sheán.
The principal tells them what happened. Seán's parents aren't happy and Seán is ashamed.
- Tá na daltaí troiblóideacha eile sa seomra feithimh lena dtuismitheoirí ag feitheamh leis an bPríomhoide.
The other troublesome students are in the waiting room with their parents, waiting on the principal.

Pictiúr 6



- Sa phictiúr deireanach, feicimid na daltaí a bhris rialacha na scoile i gcoinneáil tar éis scoile.
In the final picture, we see the students who broke the school rules in detention after school.
- Is é an píonós do chaitheamh tobaic ná uair an chloig amháin i gcoinneáil tar éis scoile agus is é an píonós do throid ná dhá uair an chloig.
The punishment for smoking is one hour in detention and the punishment for fighting is 2 hours.
- Tá na daltaí ag staidéar rialacha na scoile agus tá ceacht foghlamtha acu anois; ní bhrisfidh siad na rialacha riámh arís!
The students are studying the school rules and they've learned a lesson now; they won't break the rules ever again!

- I bpictiúr a haon, feicimid fógra crochta ar an mballa sa halla i gColáiste Phádraig.
In picture 1, we see a notice hanging on the wall in the hall in Coláiste Phádraig.
- Dar leis an bhfógra beidh an grúpa traidisiúnta ag cleachtadh ag am lón agus tar éis scoile gach Luan agus Céadaoin, más mian le héinne dul ann.
According to the notice; the trad group will be practising at lunch time and after school every Monday and Wednesday, if anyone wanted to go along.
